ACCESS TO WORLD CLASS INFRASTRUCTURE AND FREEHOLD LAND

- **868ha of freehold land**
- **Landwehr Terminal** - Two connections to the terminal in place
- **Local skilled workforce** - Several regional towns surround the project
- **Gas pipeline** - Enables hydrogen distribution

STAGED DEVELOPMENT APPROACH TARGETING HIGH DEMAND MARKETS AND FUTURE GROWTH OPPURTUNITIES

- **Solar Energy – Approvals, permits and grid connection in place** - Stage One solar facility targeting 120MW dc
- **Multiple value-add options**, including battery storage, hydrogen production and peaking power plant, being assessed during 1H24
- **Major expansion pathway** +1GW of renewable energy
- **WA electricity grid** is facing a major supply-demand deficit
